CAPE TOWN, JOBURG, SHAYAMANZI HOUSE BOAT FLYING SAFARI

8 Day (7 nights)

We move south to the mother city, Cape Town which was voted the most visited City in the world. Cape Town is known for its friendly people, scenic beauty and pleasant weather.

Visit Soweto and Johannesburg, the Golden City, founded in 1886. It has the largest subterranean gold reef in the world as well as the largest man made forest in the world.

Soak up the stunning scenery of the Lebombo Mountains and game reserve whilst on board the stunning Shayamanzi house boat. While laying in your oak paneled cabin, with hippos snorting in the nearby bay, the stars reflecting on the water and the moonlight shining through the drifting curtains, you wonder what could be more romantic.

Day 1

Touch down at O R Tambo International Airport. You will be met by your friendly and experienced tour guide who will personally assist you with the connecting domestic flight to Cape Town. You will be accompanied by our qualified guide for the duration of the tour. On arrival in Cape Town you will check-in at a four star hotel which is situated at the Victoria Alfred Waterfront. Spend some time at the beautiful Victoria & Alfred waterfront, popular for its live music (jazz and African music), pubs, restaurants and stunning views of the harbour and Table Mountain.

Day 2

Enjoy a half day Cape Town Tour. A visit to the Castle of Good Hope which is South Africa's oldest colonial building (it was the headquarters of the Dutch East India Company from 1666). Explore the beautiful beaches, seaside villages and the floral beauty of Table Mountain. Enjoy a light lunch at the Botanical Gardens tea garden.

Day 3

We depart for a full day tour of the Cape Peninsula and Cape Point, where the Atlantic and Indian Oceans meet. It has an abundant fauna and flora and is Africa's most south western point. It has two light houses and restaurants where whale sightings are a highlight. We take a scenic drive along the coastline through Bantry Bay, Camps Bay and Hout Bay and stop for fish & chips at popular restaurants along this route.

Day 4

Set off into the beautiful country for a full day tour of the Cape winelands. Enjoy champagne and wine tasting at a multitude of wine farms the heart of South Africa's renowned wine industry. There are over two hundred wine cellars along this route. *It is the longest wine route in the world.* The region is famous for its food and wine.

Day 5

Depart from Cape Town International Airport on a commercial flight to O R Tambo International Airport, Johannesburg. Enjoy a half day personalised guided tour of Soweto and Johannesburg. Check-in at a country estate luxury 4 star guest house where you can relax and enjoy an evening braai (Barbeque) under the African star studded sky.

Day 6 (2 hour flight)

Take off from Grand Central Airport, Johannesburg, for a scenic flight over the escarpment to the warm northern part of KwaZulu-Natal. The large lake is surrounded by game reserves which have a large variety of wild life. The Shayamanzi house boats are fully serviced. Enjoy delicious meals, great tiger fishing, and bird watching or just relax around the Jacuzzi and absorb the African sun.

Day 7

Enjoy another day on board this luxury house boat, Shayamanzi. The chef provides meals which consist of an early cold breakfast, hot brunch, lunch and three course dinners. While cruising on the lake you can relax around the Jacuzzi and do some game viewing, tiger fishing and bird watching of more than 300 species.

What could be more romantic or relaxing?

Day 8 (30 min. flight)

Enjoy a lovely breakfast and return to the airfield for a flight back to Johannesburg.
